Develop student goals/objectives and consult with teachers, administrators, and related service providers on an ongoing basis to monitor the educational program;

Participate on a multidisciplinary team in the development of IEP and facilitate IEP meetings; Provide written reports analyzing, interpreting and summarizing test results, observations and information from school personnel, students and parents;
